

1 Guide to IPv4 Pre-approval in MyAPNIC

This guide explains how to submit your Pre-approval request from MyAPNIC.

1.1 Completing the Transfer Pre-approval form

In preparation for receiving IPv4 address transfers, the recipient account may choose to request preapproval by completing the "Transfer Pre-approval" form, which can be found under the Resources menu of MyAPNIC. By getting pre-approval, the recipient account avoids having to demonstrate the need for receiving IP resources when a source of transfer is located and the transfer size is within the pre-approval.






1.1.1 Transfer Pre-approval form

The "Transfer Pre-approval" form will prompt you to complete the resource request form to demonstrate your IPv4 requirement. The APNIC Registration Services team will then evaluate your request for pre-approval.

If your re-approval request is approved, APNIC Registration Services will inform you of the approved size of the pre-approval. You can also check your pre-approval details in MyAPNIC.



You will also be given the option to list your pre-approval in the "IPv4 Transfer Listing Service" web page.

APNIC provides a listing page to enable a source of IPv4 transfers to contact a pre-approved recipient before a transfer is initiated.

1.2 **Pre-approval validity**

Pre-approvals are valid for 24 months. If your IPv4 requirements change, you can lodge a subsequent new pre-approval request. If the new request is approved, it will override your existing request.

If the size of the IPv4 transfer you wish to receive is greater then your pre-approval, you will be prompted to complete the resource request form to provide additional justification to receive the transfer.
