Policy Proposals to be discussed at APNIC 42

The Open Policy Meeting on 5 October 2016 at APNIC 42 in Colombo, Sri Lanka, will consider the following policy proposals.

prop-116: Prohibit transfer of IPv4 addresses in final /8 block

This proposal seeks to block the ability to transfer addresses delegated under the 'Final /8' policy (prop-062). These blocks are from the 103/8 range and are intended to provide a small amount of address space to allow existing and new Members a final block to connect to the IPv6 Internet.

The proposal points to examples where 103/8 blocks appear to have been obtained for the sole purpose of transfer and tries to prevent this by stopping the transfer of all resources in this range.

Proposal to revise SIG Chair election procedures

This proposal identifies two issues with the current SIG Chair election procedures and seeks to resolve them. First, it classifies remote participants as eligible voters in the election and second, ensures the two-years term of service are aligned for Chair and Co-Chair, even after the early resignation of a Chair.
