This work is very important as it serves as preparation for the new requirements that will likely arrive next year with the global adoption of the RIR Governance Document, which has been developed by the Internet community as part of a review of ICANN's Internet Coordination Policy 2 (ICP-2) document. While the original ICP-2 sets down the criteria for recognising new RIRs, the updated document will cover the expectations for how existing RIRs operate. It will create more stringent requirements that all RIRs, including APNIC – and by extension, all NIRs, including IDNIC – will need to abide by. This includes regular audits by ICANN.

The adoption of the RIR Governance Document marks a new chapter with a strengthened global Internet Numbers Registry system. APNIC looks forward to continuing our successful relationship with APJII well into the future.
