Dear Giang and Thu Thuy,

RE: Additional documentation for Number Resource applications

Thank you for VNNIC's ongoing cooperation with APNIC as we progress the review of resource delegations across all National Internet Registries (NIRs) to ensure registry accuracy.

As you are aware, all delegations of Internet Number Resources in the APNIC region are governed by Address Management Policies created by the community. Under the terms of the [APNIC and NIR Member Relationship Agreement](#) entered into by VNNIC and APNIC, VNNIC must comply with all APNIC Address Management Policies.

We note that the Viet Nam Government has also decreed that within Viet Nam, 'the allocation and assignment of Internet addresses and network numbers shall be consistent with the Internet address and network number allocation and assignment policies stipulated by APNIC' (Article 17.2(b) of [Decree 147/2024/ND-CP](#)).

APNIC address policy states that Internet number addresses (such as IPv4) are a 'public resource that should only be distributed according to demonstrated need' ([Section 3.2.6](#), APNIC Internet Number Resource Policies). In order to properly evaluate IPv4 resource applications, APNIC policy requires relevant documentation to be submitted by applicants to ensure that their need for resources has been demonstrated ([Section 5.6](#), APNIC Internet Number Resource Policies).

As such, the following documents should be provided to VNNIC by applicants as part of all number resource requests to assist with evidencing 'need':

- The applicant's contract with their upstream provider
- Invoices for routing equipment or a service contract with an infrastructure provider
- A plan which shows how the addresses will be used, plus any relevant network diagrams
