






APNIC Resource Summary

- Free resources available
 - IP 54% free (total 5 x /8)
 - ASN 35% free (total 1500 ASNs)
- Consumption rate (3 years)
 - IP 520,000 IP/month (0.37 x /8 per year)
 - ASN 17 ASN/month (~200 per year)
- Consumption rate (1999)
 - IP 795,000 IP/month (0.57 x /8 per year)
 - ASN 22 ASN/month (~260 per year)






IP Allocation - Distribution





ASN Allocation - Distribution


















- Allocation service launched
