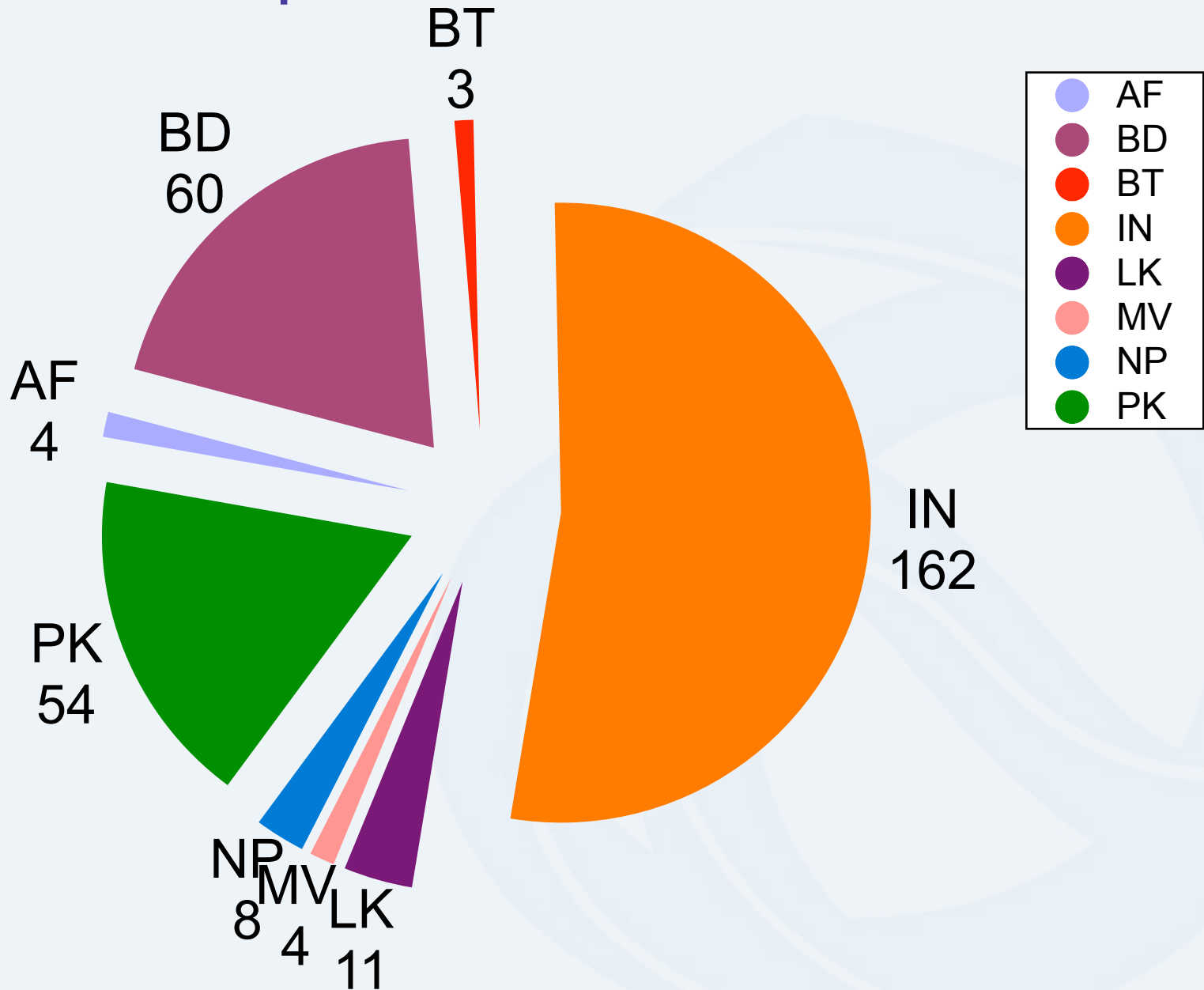
About APNIC

 - Bottom up policy & decision making processes

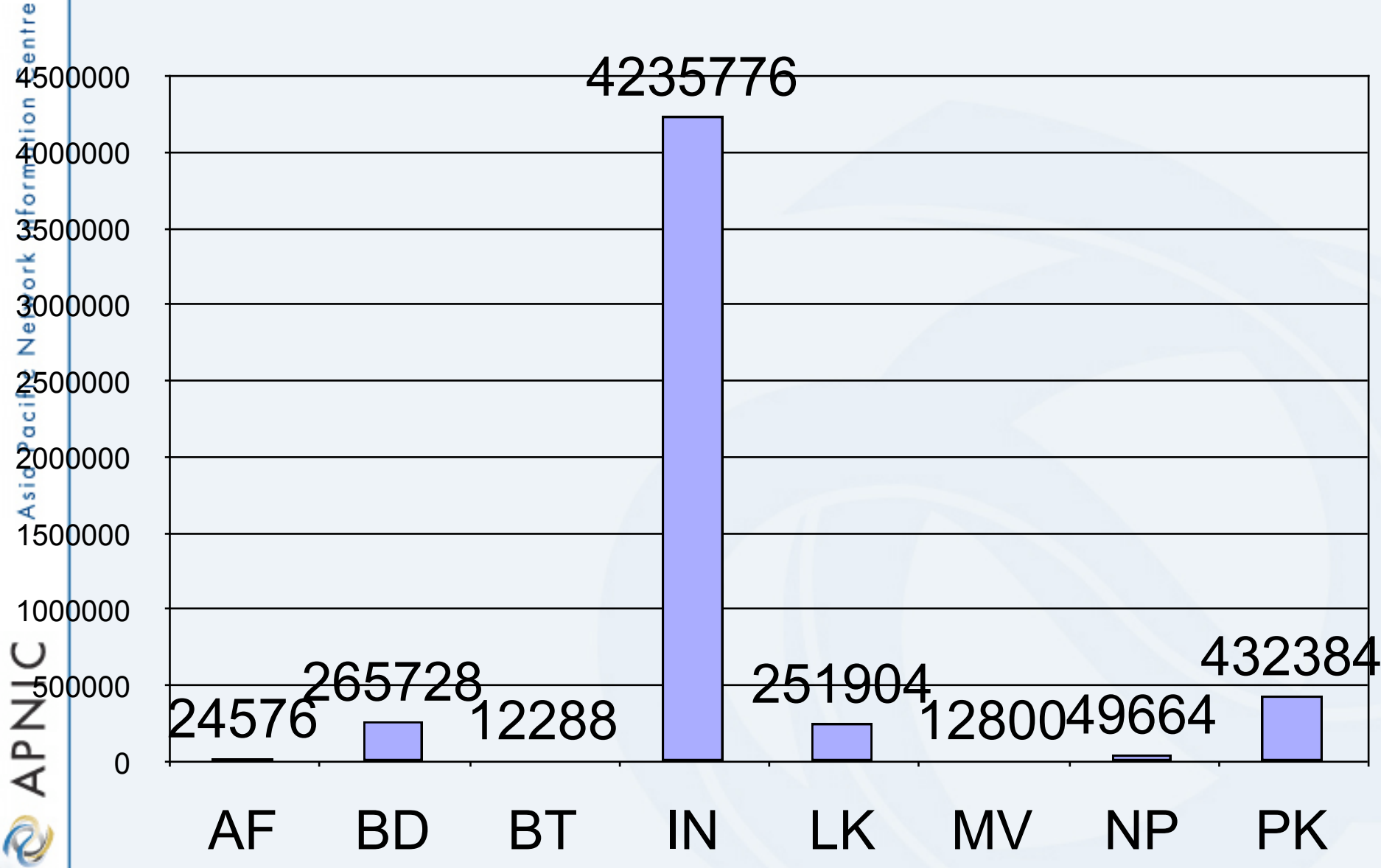

Total IPv4 delegations in SA

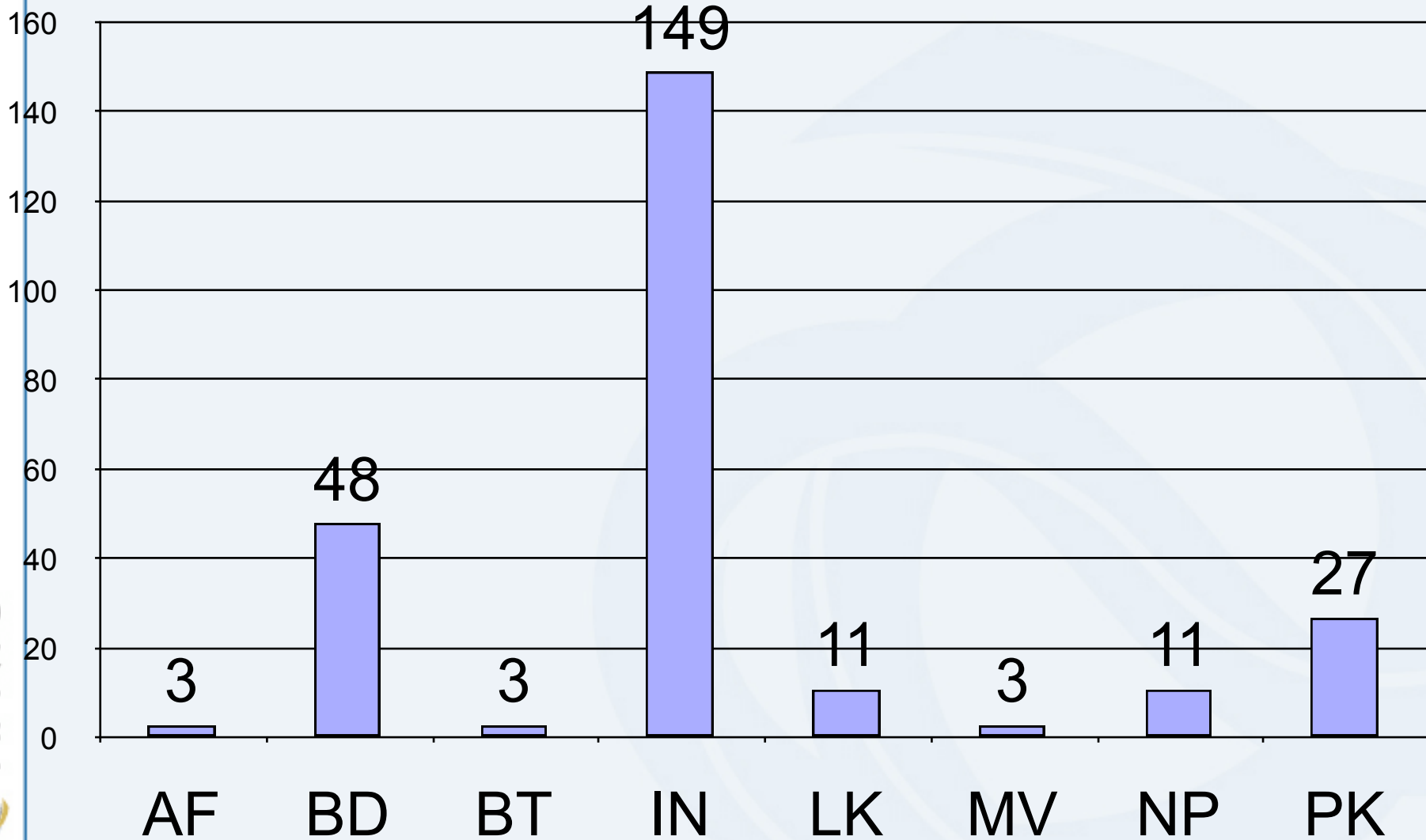


IPv6 allocations in SA

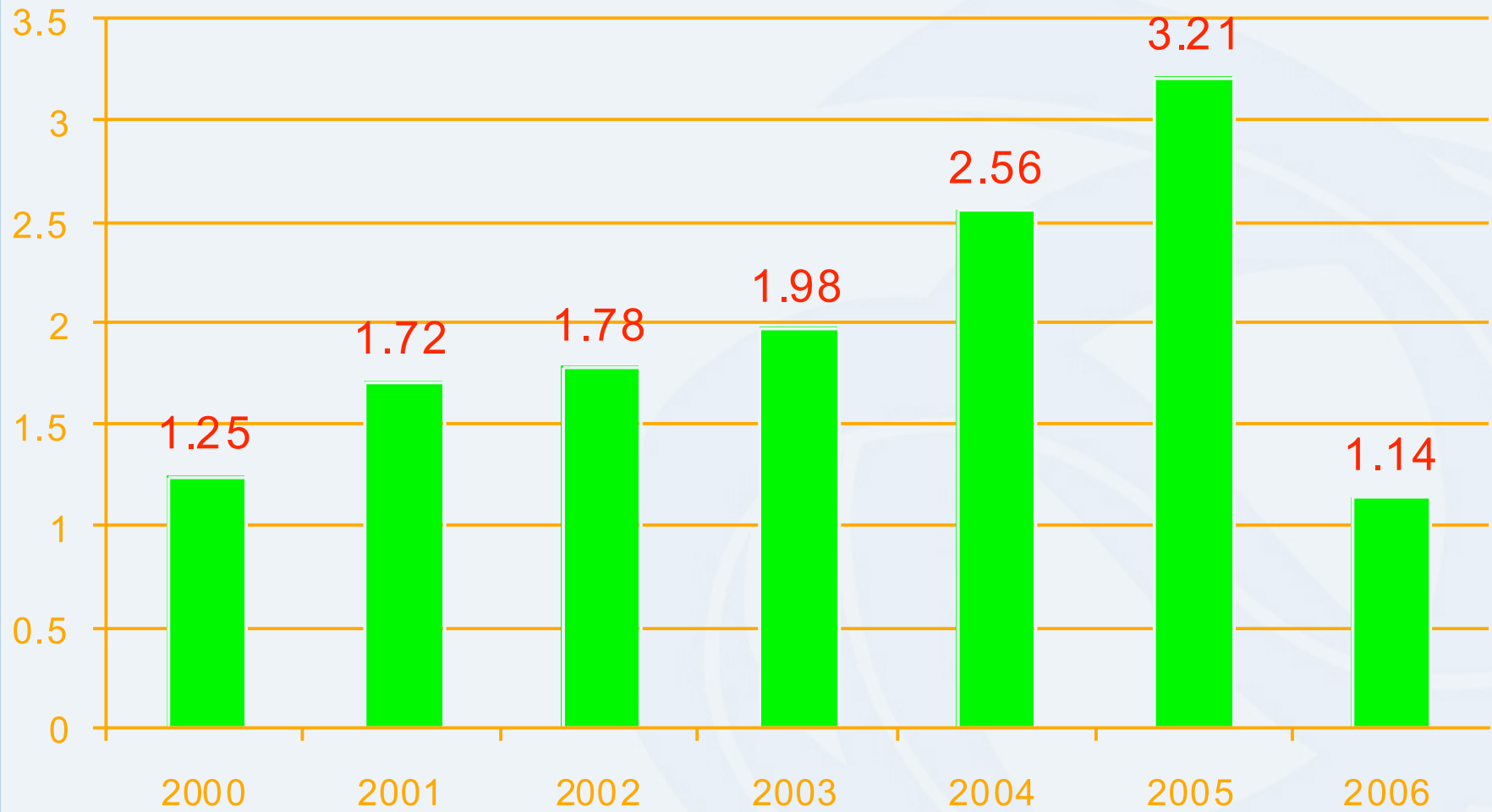

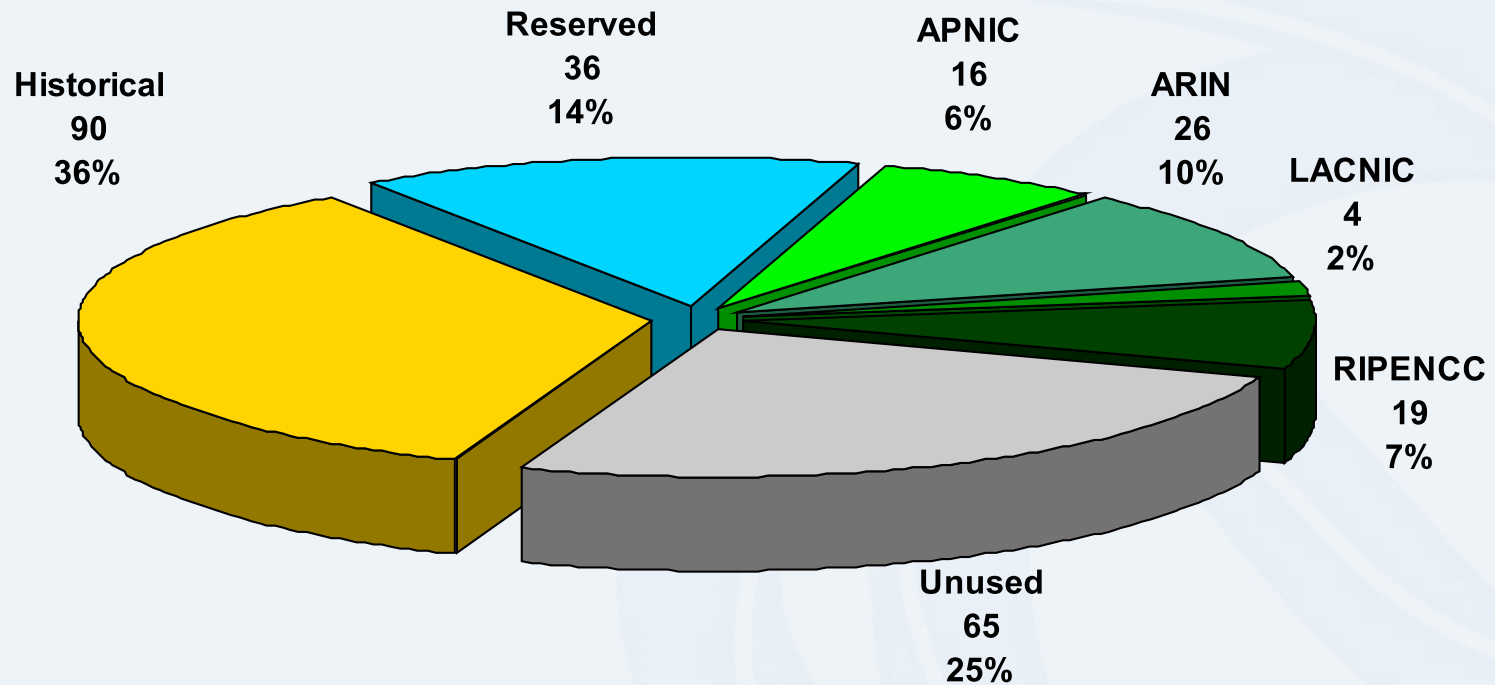
ASN assignments in SA

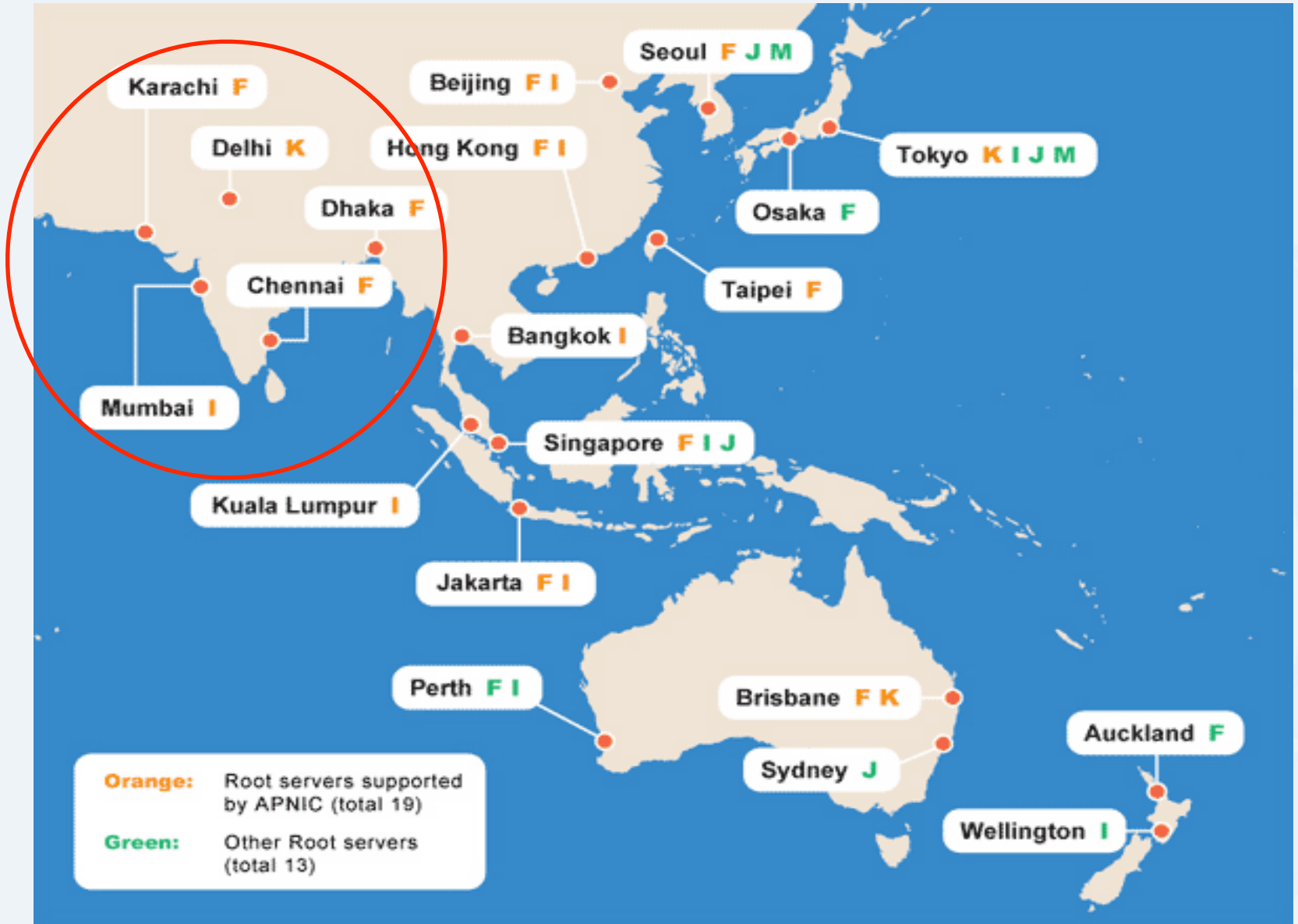

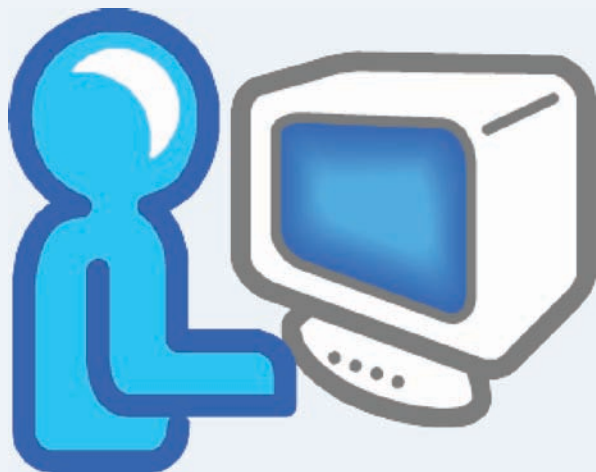


