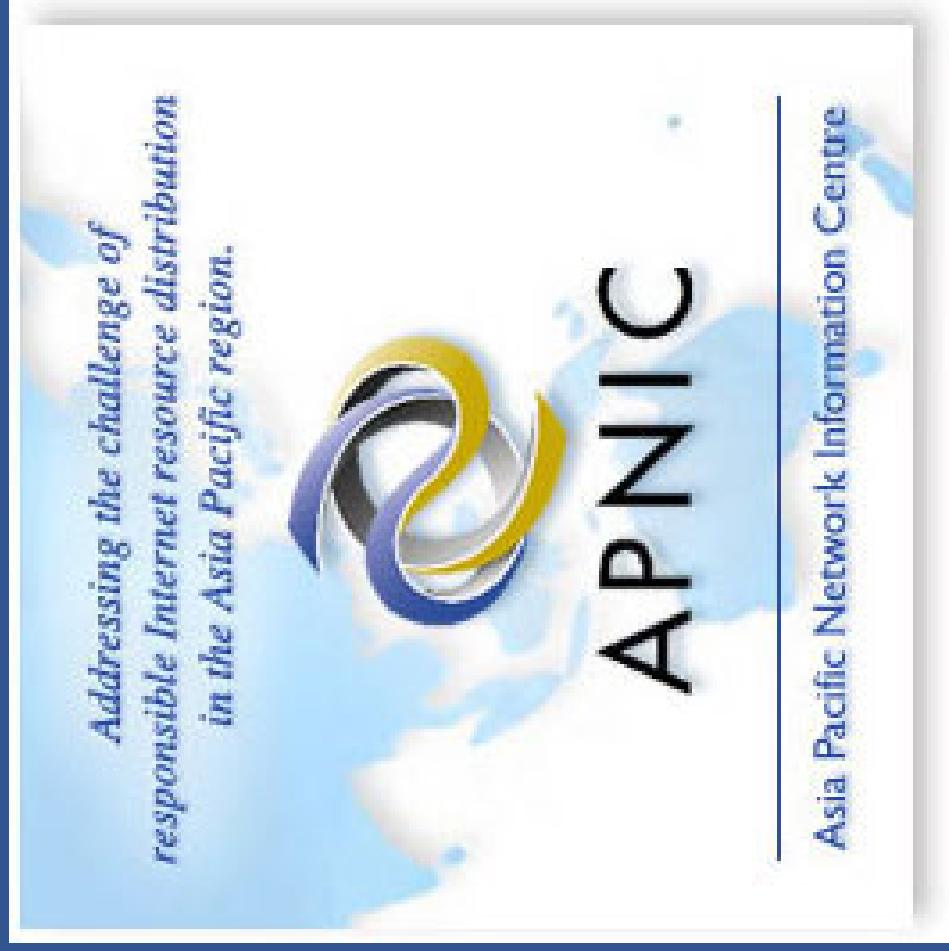

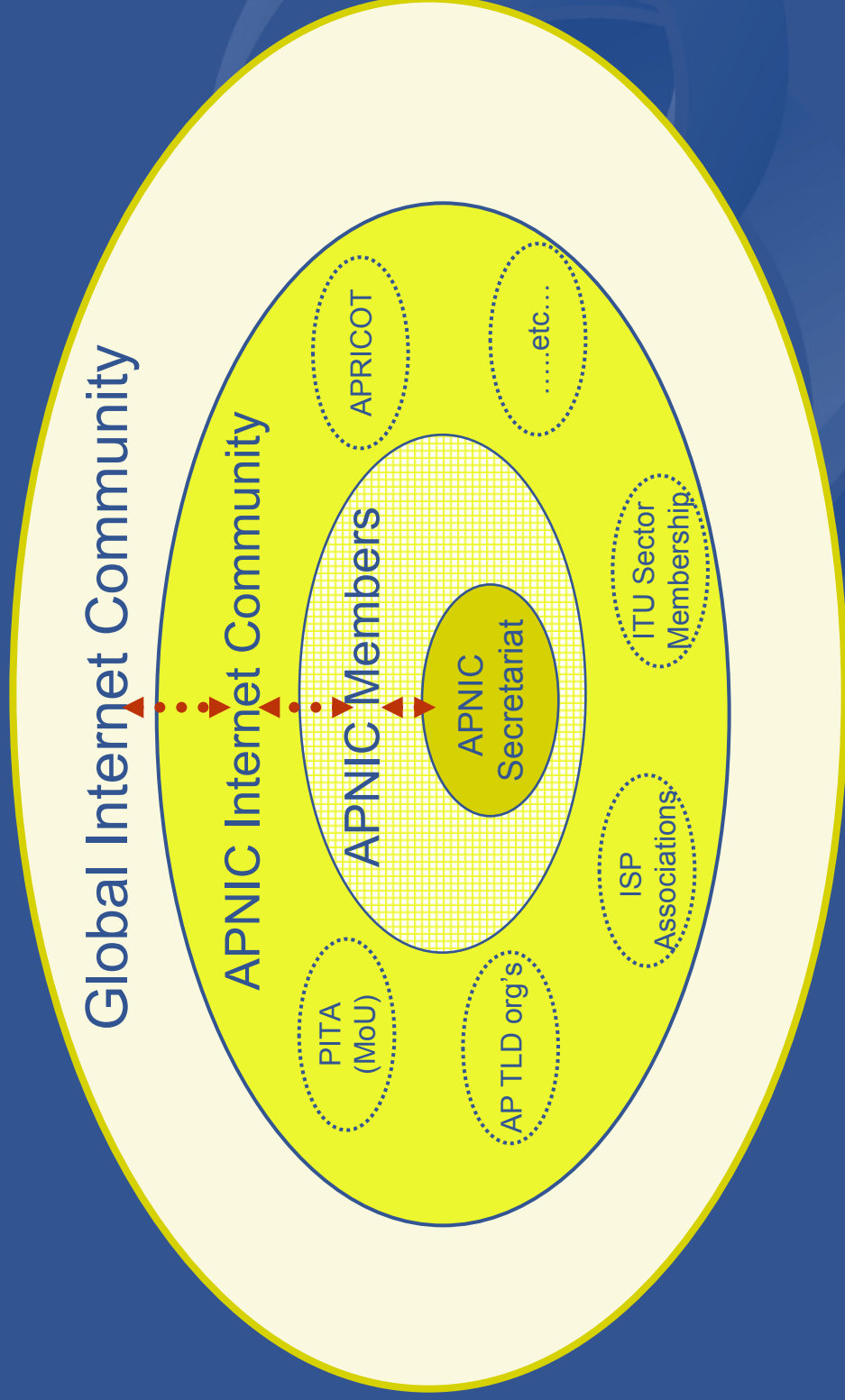
What is APNIC?

- Regional Internet Registry
 - Asia Pacific region
 - Non-profit, neutral and independent
- What is an RIR?
 - Regional authority for Internet Resource distribution
 - IPv4 & IPv6 addresses
 - Autonomous System numbers
 - Reverse DNS delegation

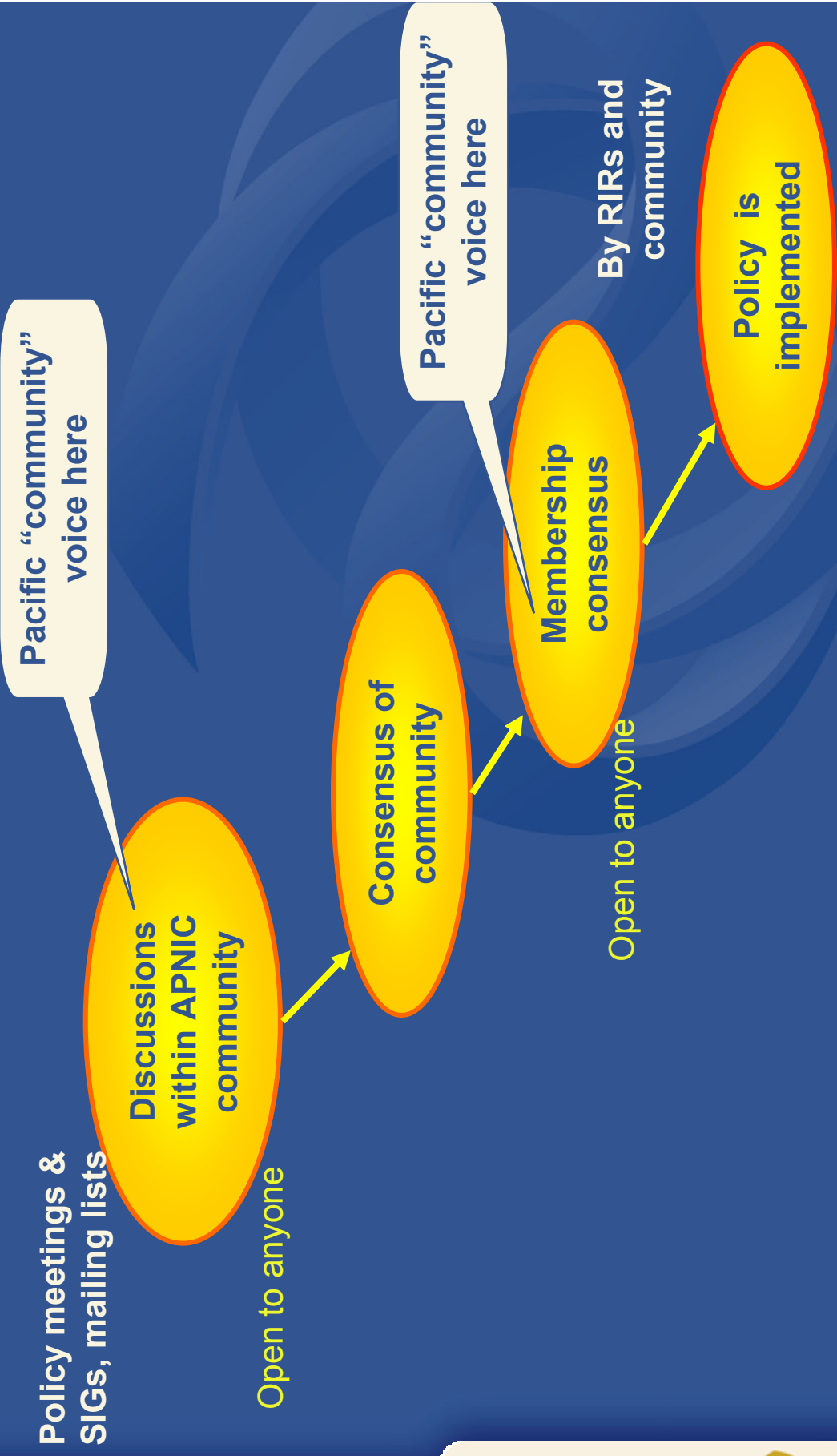
More about APNIC...

- Industry self-regulatory body
 - Open to participation by anyone with an interest in the management of Internet resources
 - “Regulation” is done by APNIC “community”
- Is NOT
 - Top-down but bottom-up consensus based policy decision making
 - Technical standards body (like IETF)
 - Registry or registrar for domain names

Self-regulation in Practice – The Policy Process






Participation is Easy and Important!

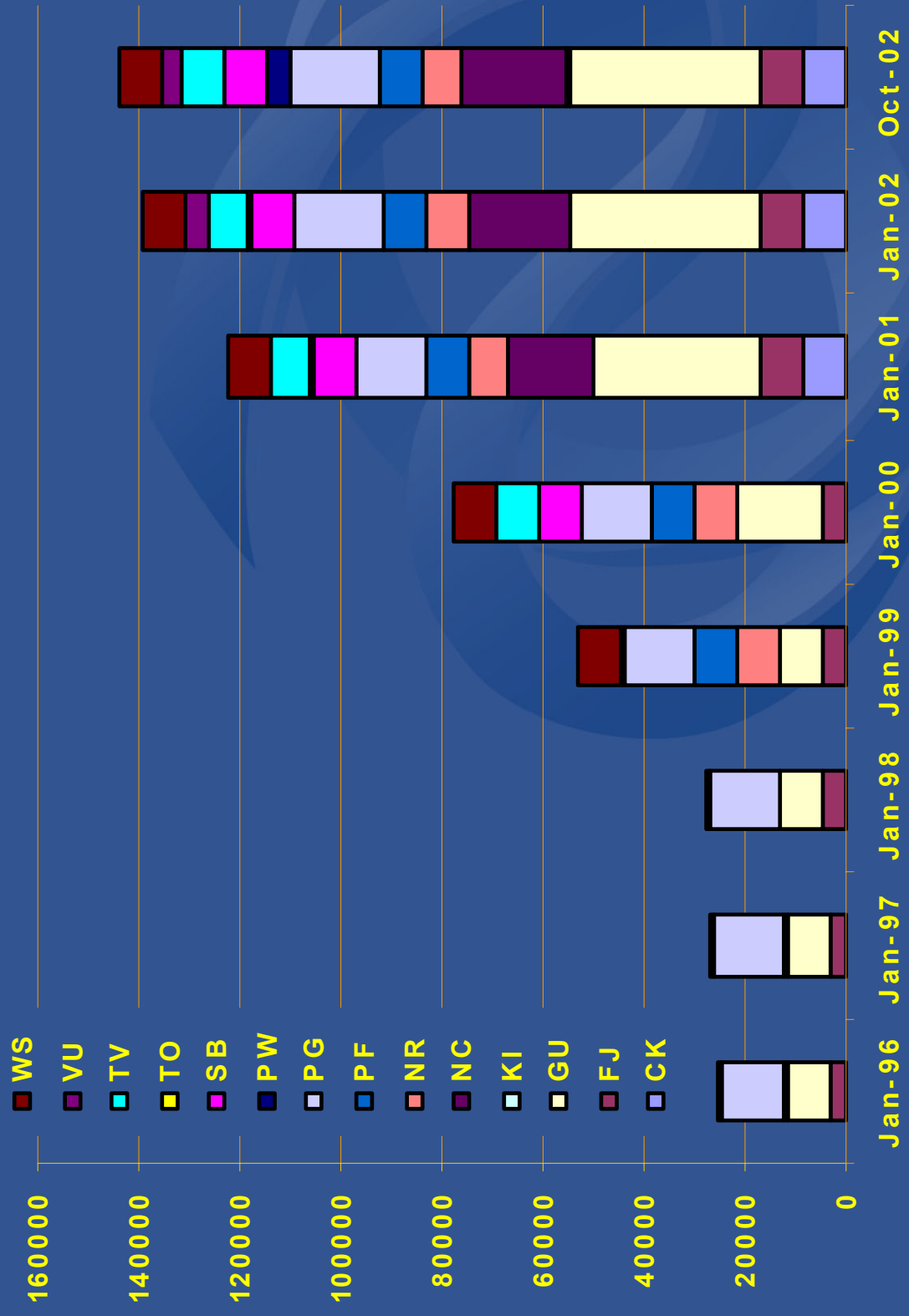
Pacific Update



Update for Pacific

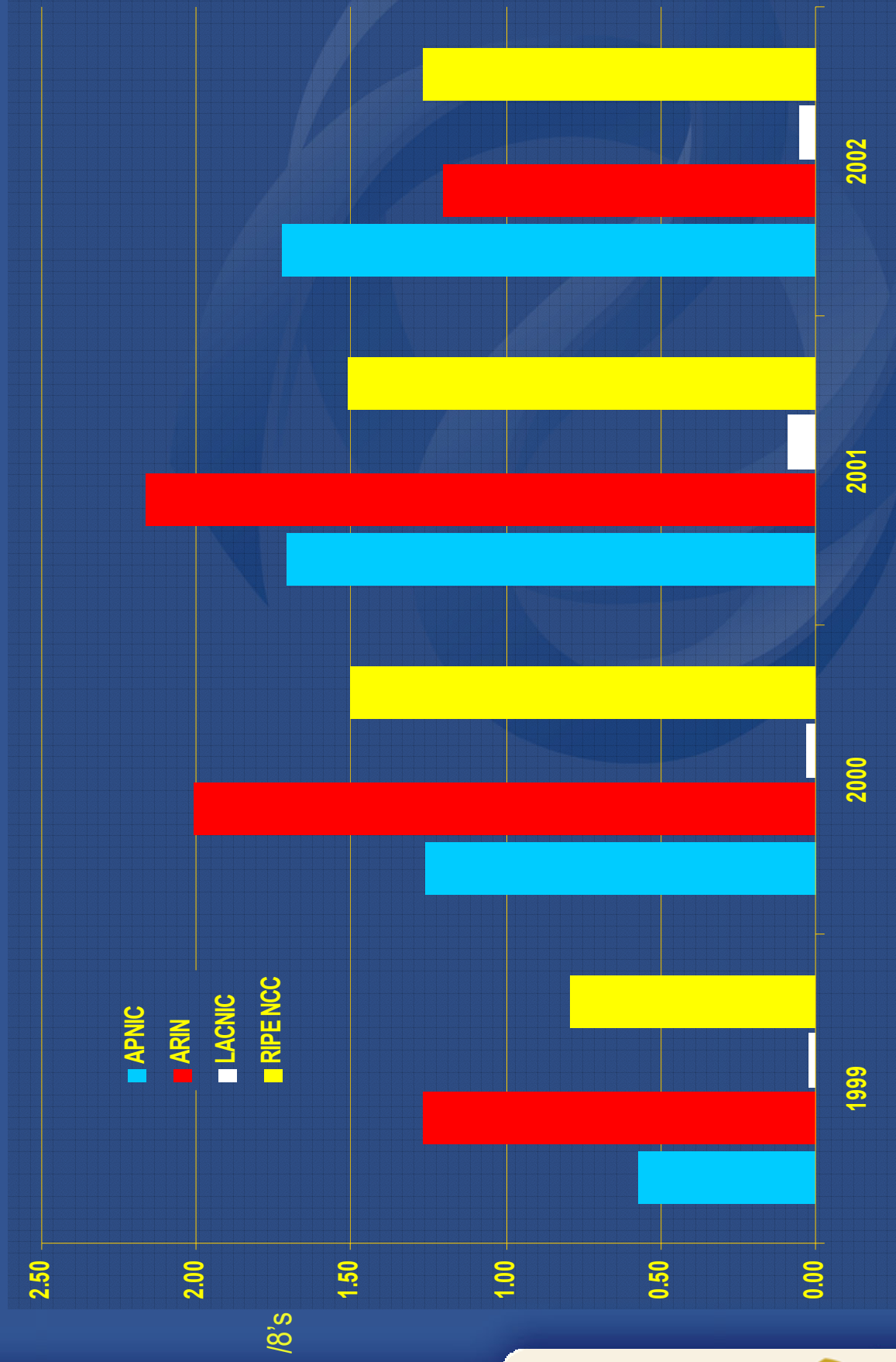
- **Activities since Nov 2002**
