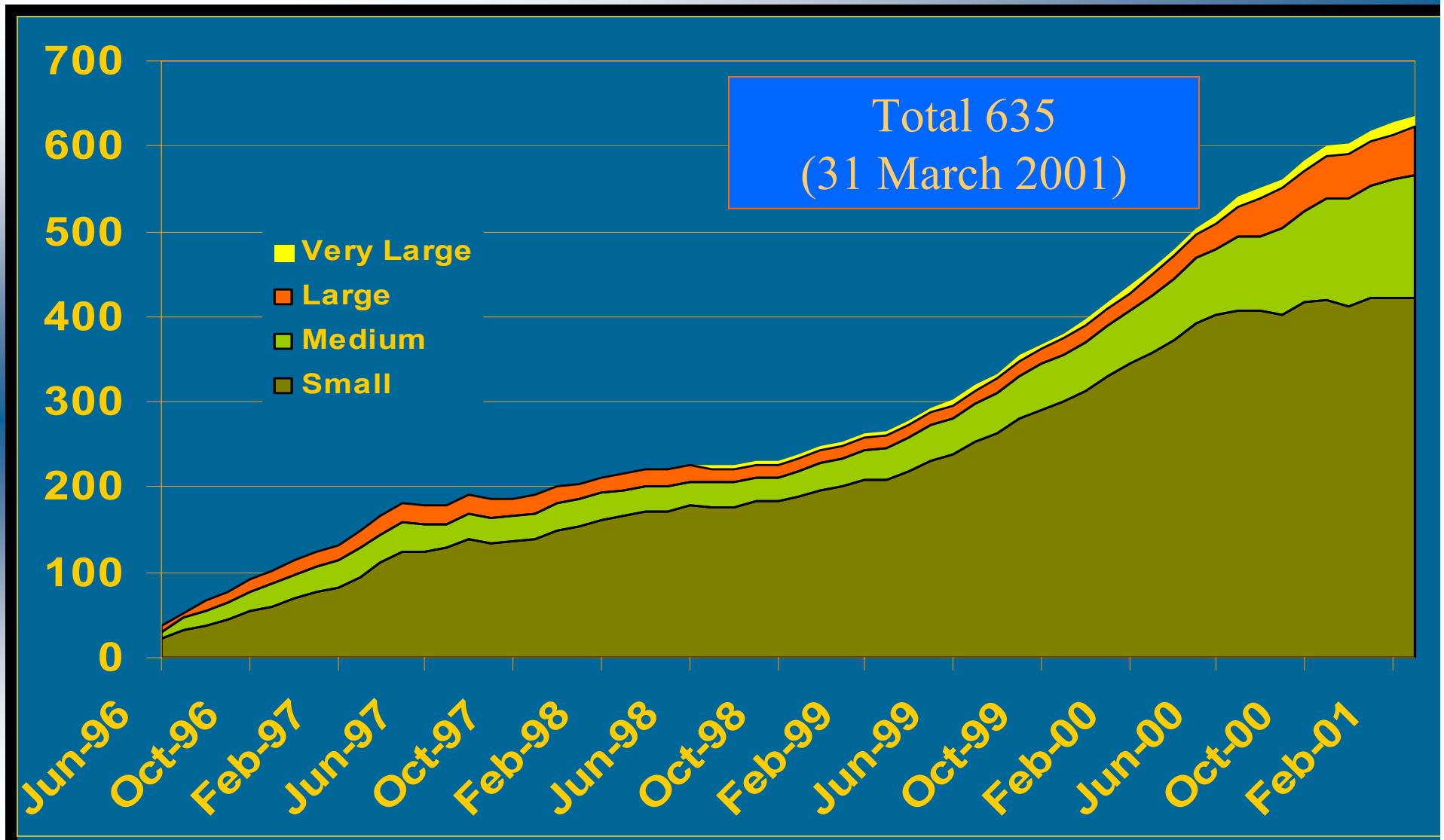

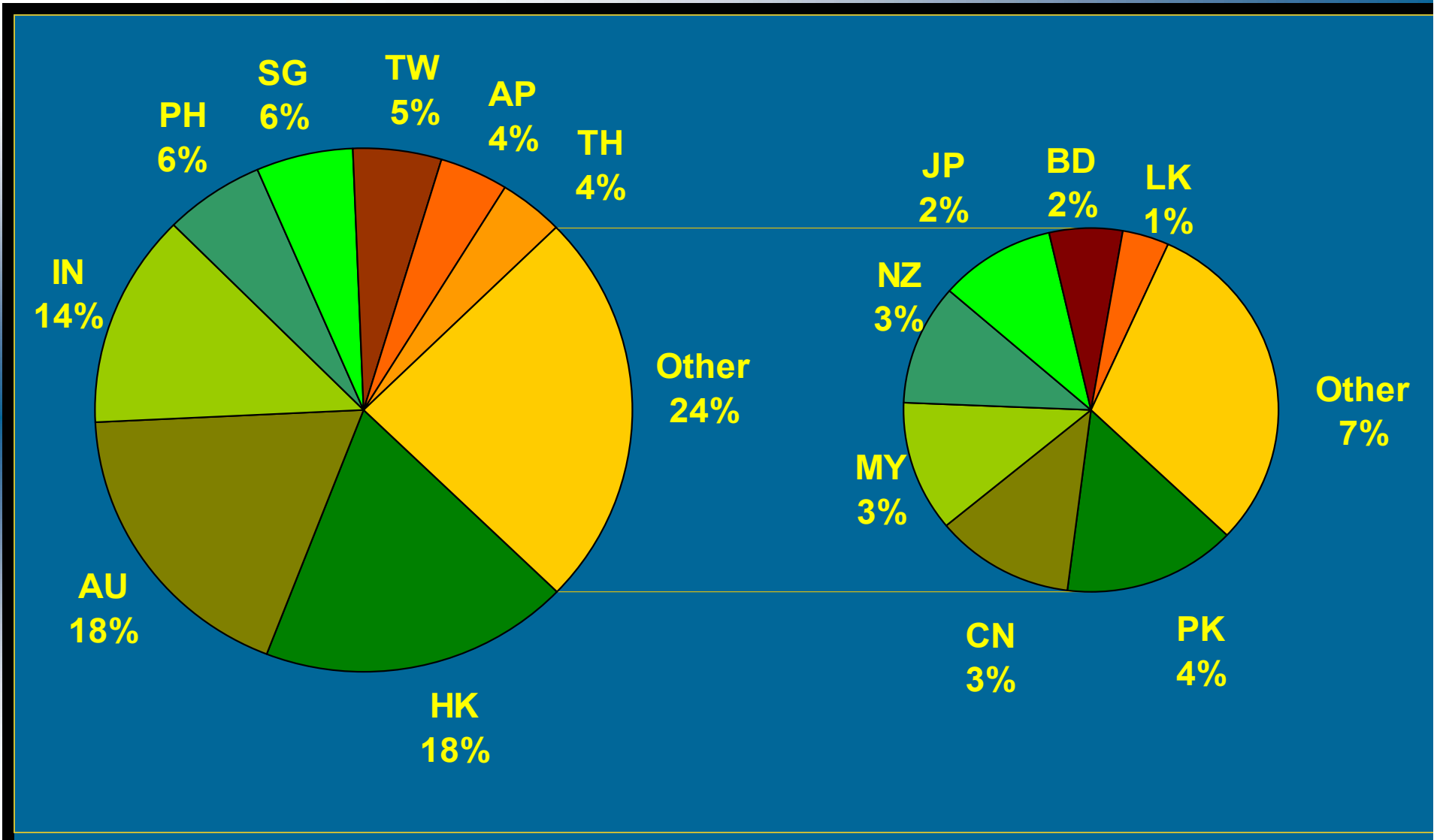


How many APNIC Members?





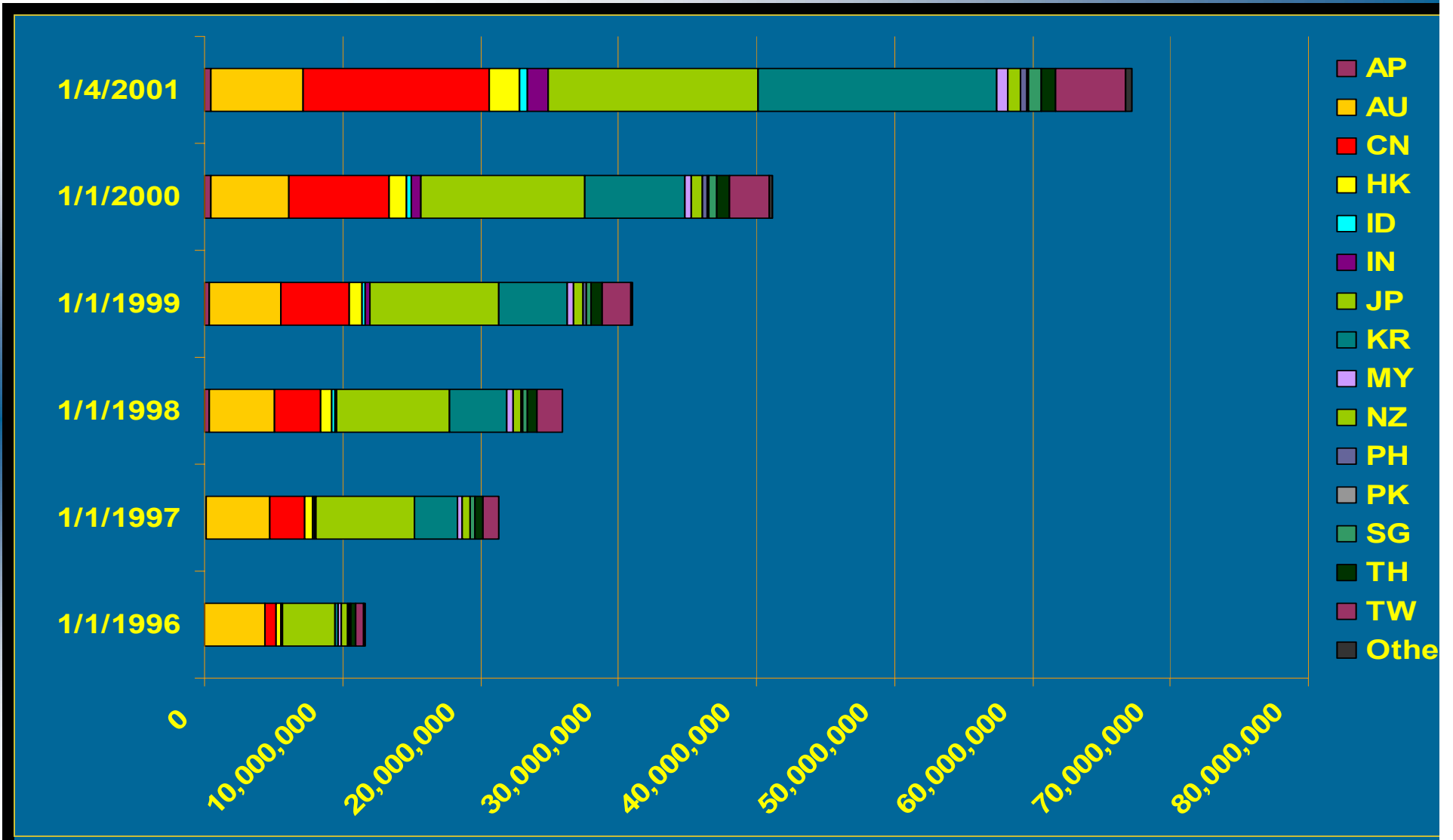
Where are APNIC Members?



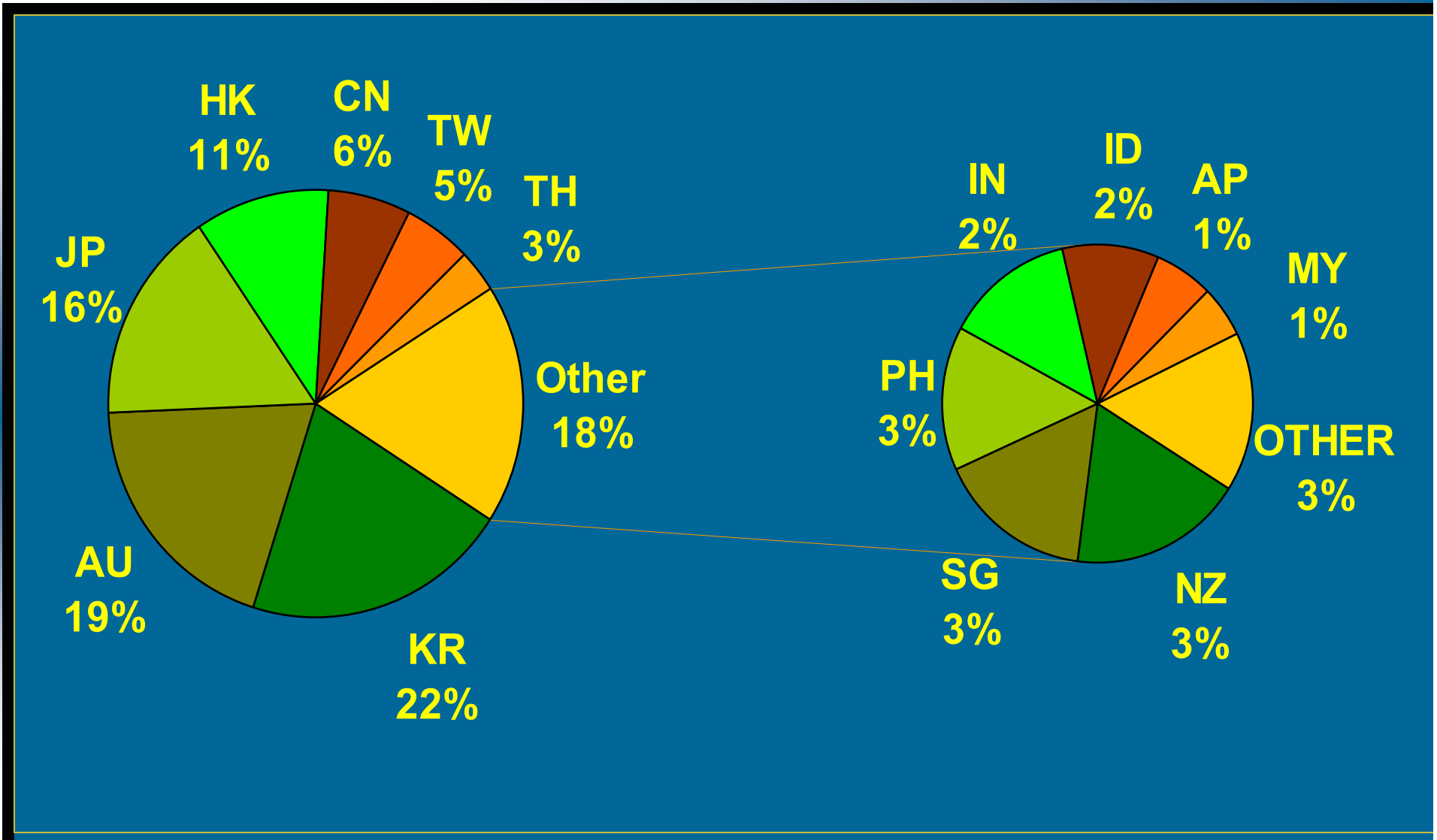

ASN Allocations - Distribution

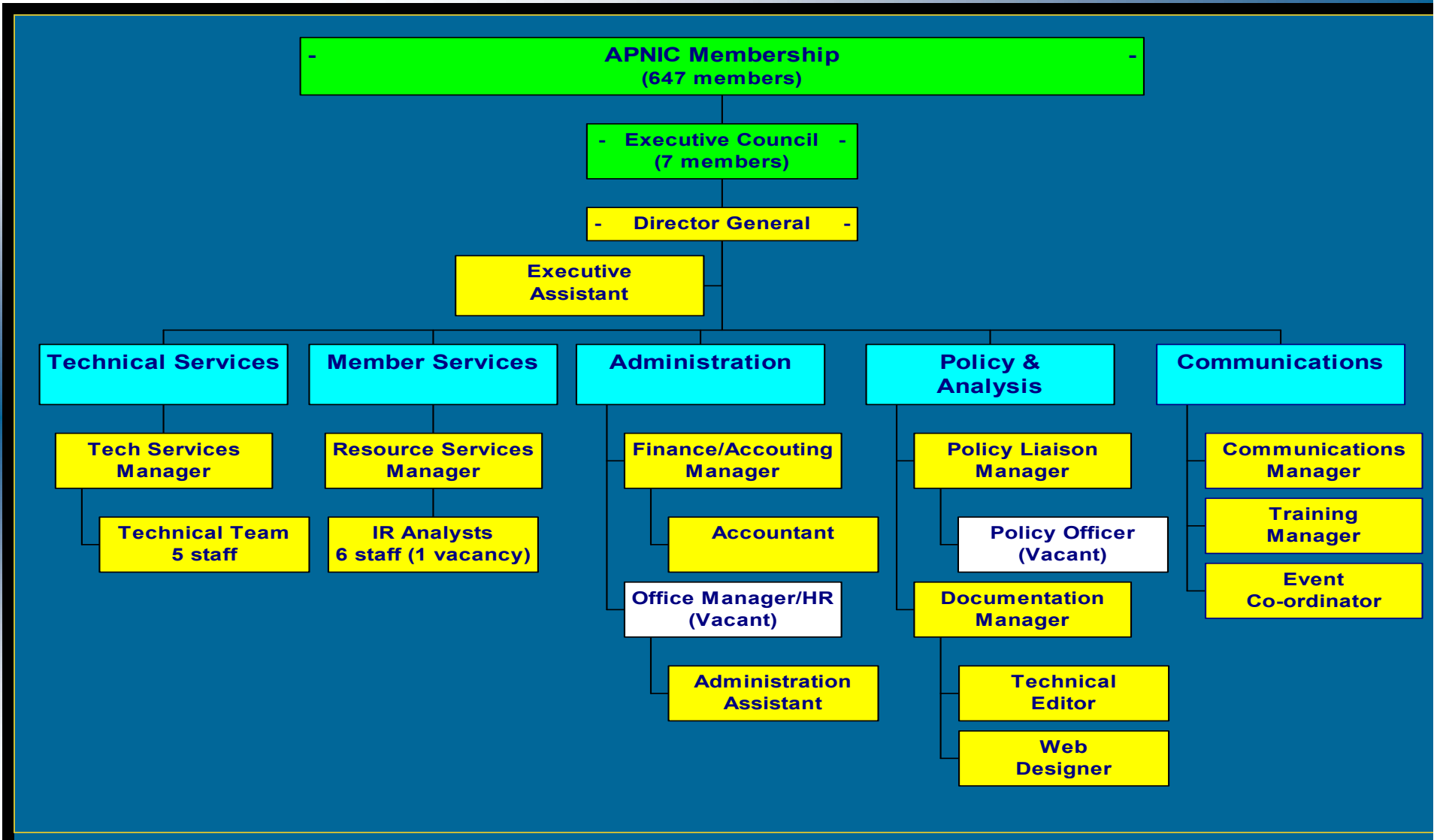

- ◆ Developments
 - ◆ Most recent course in HK attracted 100+
 - ◆ New 6 month schedule on web site
 - ◆ Translated material into Mandarin Chinese
 - ◆ Thanks to CNNIC
- ◆ Plans for 2001
 - ◆ Develop material to support RPSL deployment
 - ◆ Develop more advanced modules
 - ◆ Investigate distance learning (CBT)

- ◆ Outreach
 - ◆ Training combined with outreach
 - ◆ Extending number of public seminars with APTLD on Internet Governance
- ◆ New - Sponsorship
 - ◆ Developing programme to attract training sponsors
 - ◆ Courses still subsidised by APNIC
 - ◆ Aim to keep costs as low as possible



Policy Developments

- ◆ PI/PA policy consistent
 - ◆ To have a clearer and consistent expression of **one** means by which to receive PI/PA space
- ◆ ‘Rough’ consensus at last meeting
 - ◆ More discussion needed but APNIC should change policies in the interim to improve transparency
- ◆ New policy details for /20 PI/PA
 - ◆ /22 used from upstream
 - ◆ Applicant agrees to renumber



Service Developments

- ◆ RIPE DBv3
 - ◆ Testing now but 6-9 months behind RIPE NCC
 - ◆ Public beta with APNIC data
 - ◆ Now working on update of schema
- ◆ IRR
 - ◆ 8 week pilot project
 - ◆ To document operational requirements and highlight deployment issues
