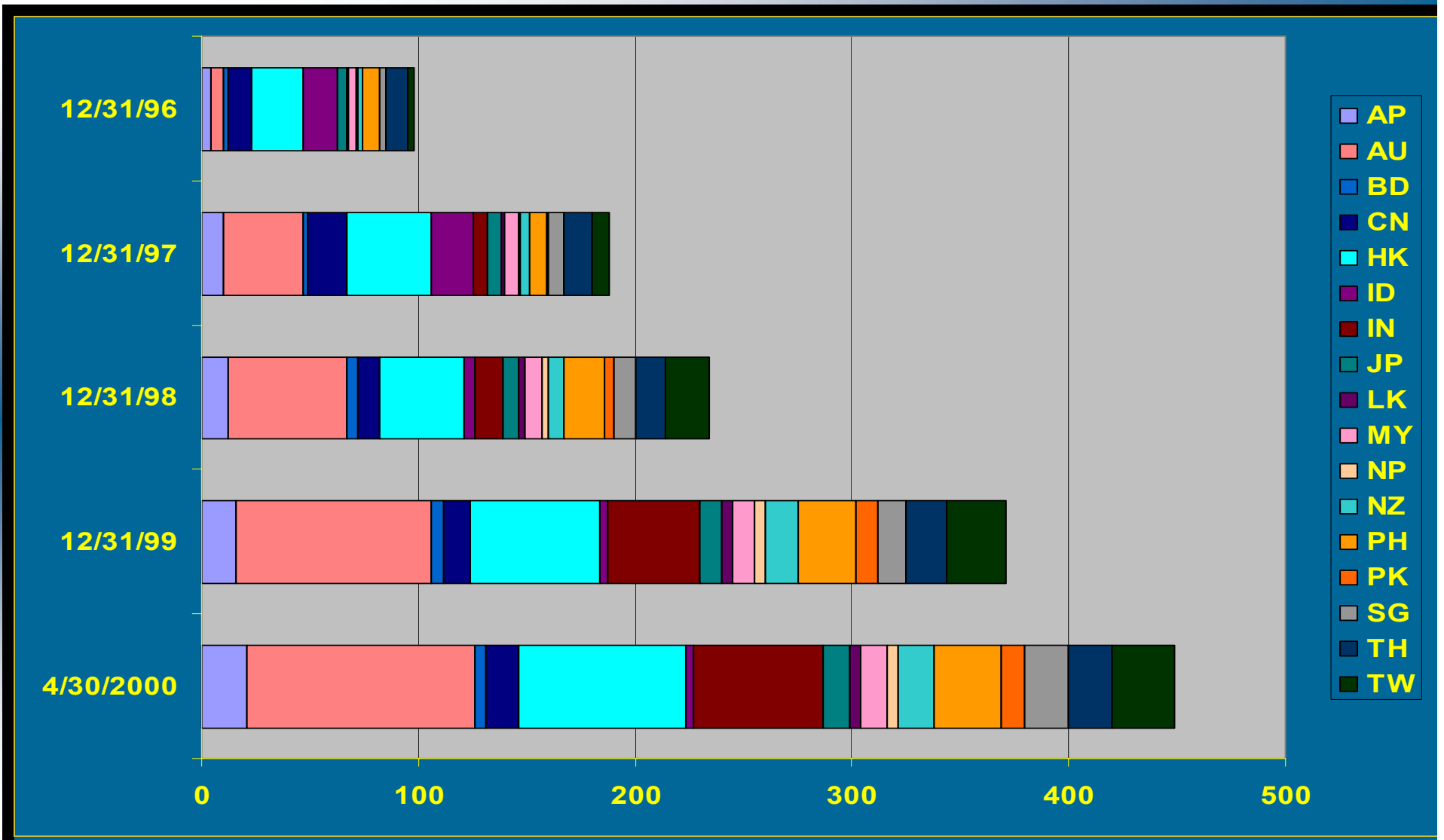


Policy Changes

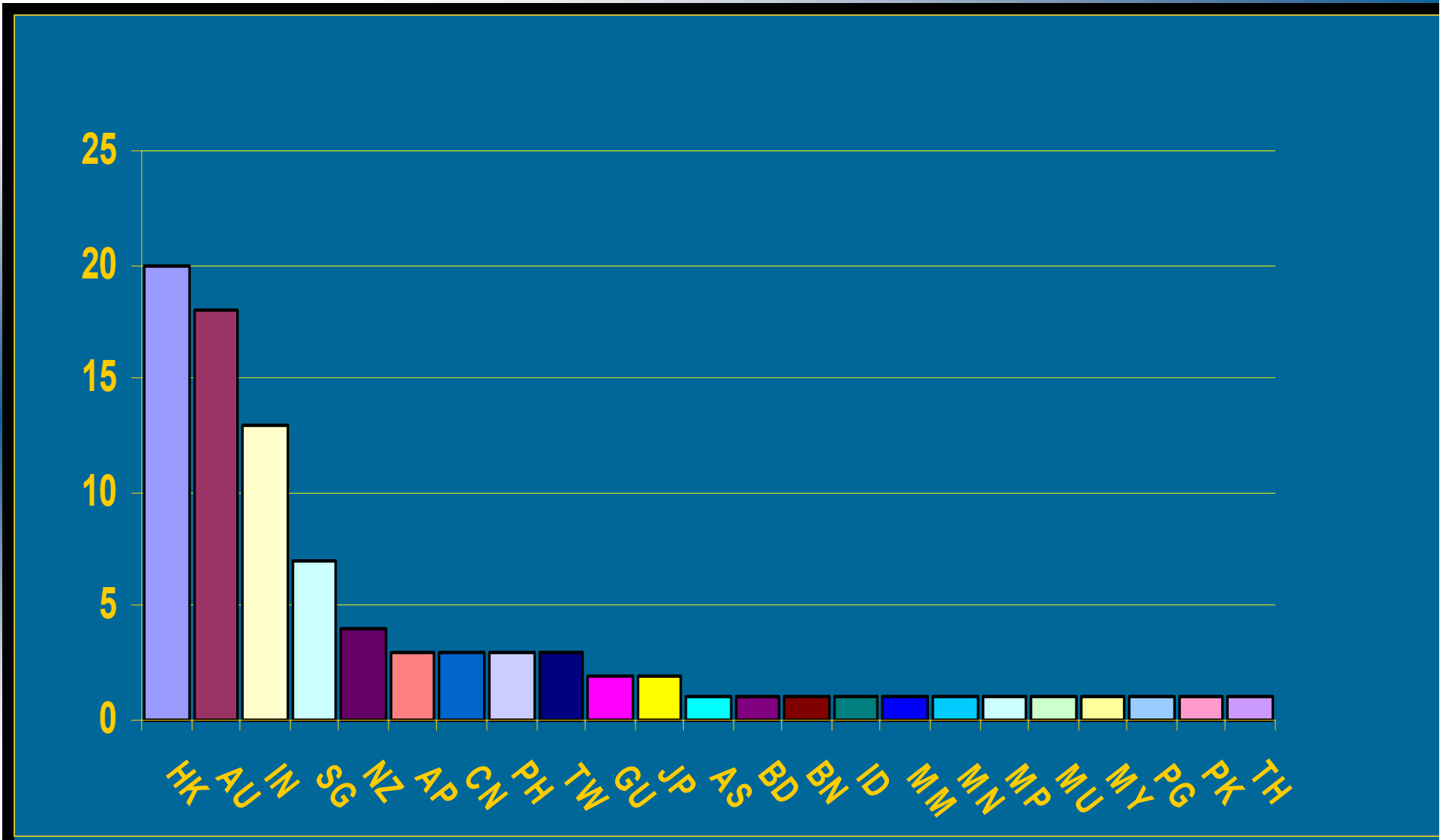
- ◆ Consensus on...

 - ◆ Name-based webhosting 'strongly encouraged'
 - ◆ Lease-based address allocation framework

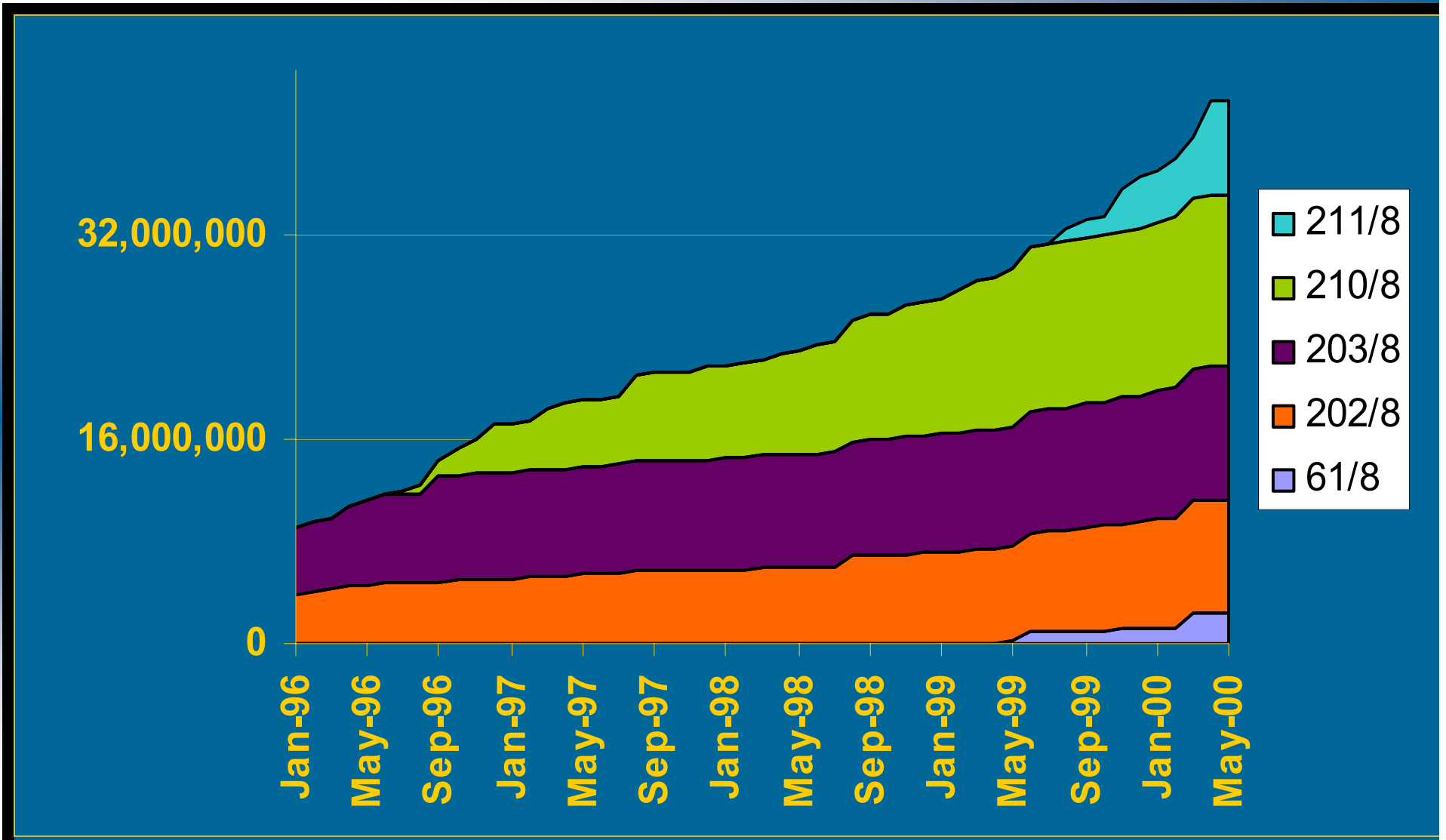

IPv4 Address Space Usage

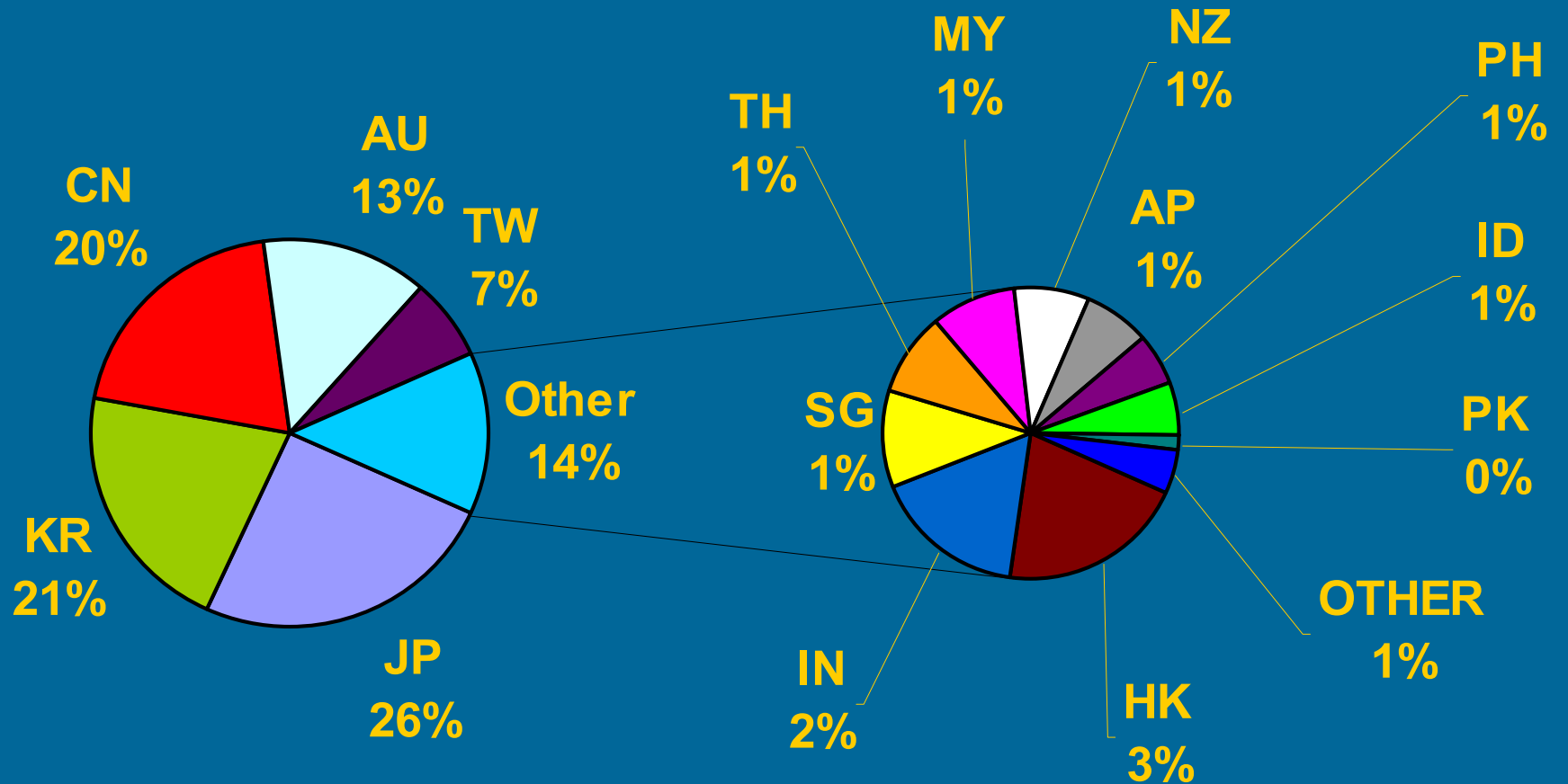




APNIC Resource Status

- ◆ Consumption rate (3 years)
 - ◆ 590,000 IPv4/month (0.42 x /8 p.a.)
 - ◆ 22 ASN/month (264 p.a.)
- ◆ Consumption rate (1999)
 - ◆ 807,000 IPv4/month (0.58 x /8 p.a.)
 - ◆ 27 ASN/month (324 p.a.)
- ◆ Consumption rate (last 12 months)
 - ◆ 1,152,469 IPv4/month (0.82 x /8 p.a.)
 - ◆ 40 ASN/month (480 p.a.)

IPv4 Allocations - Distribution

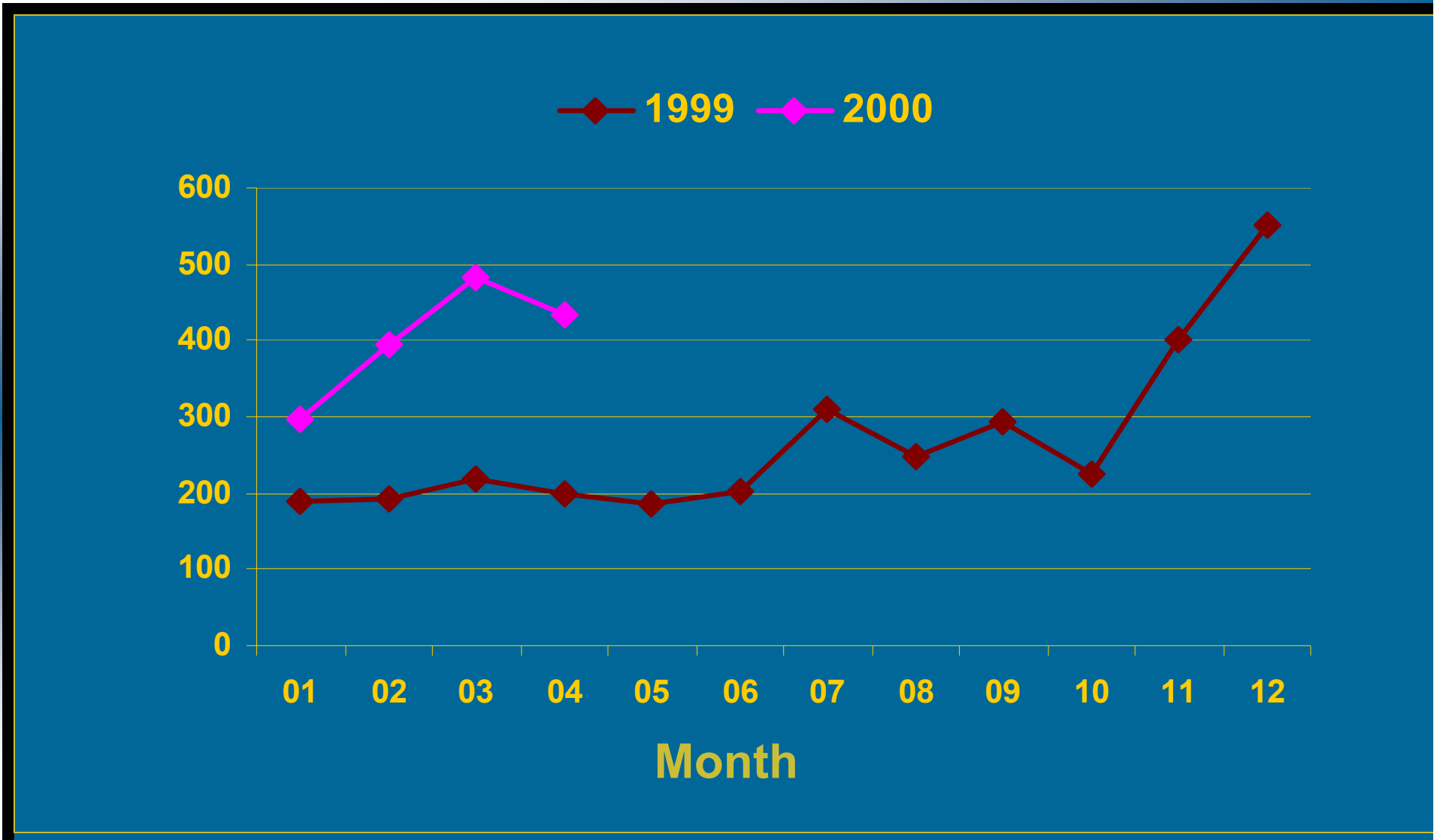




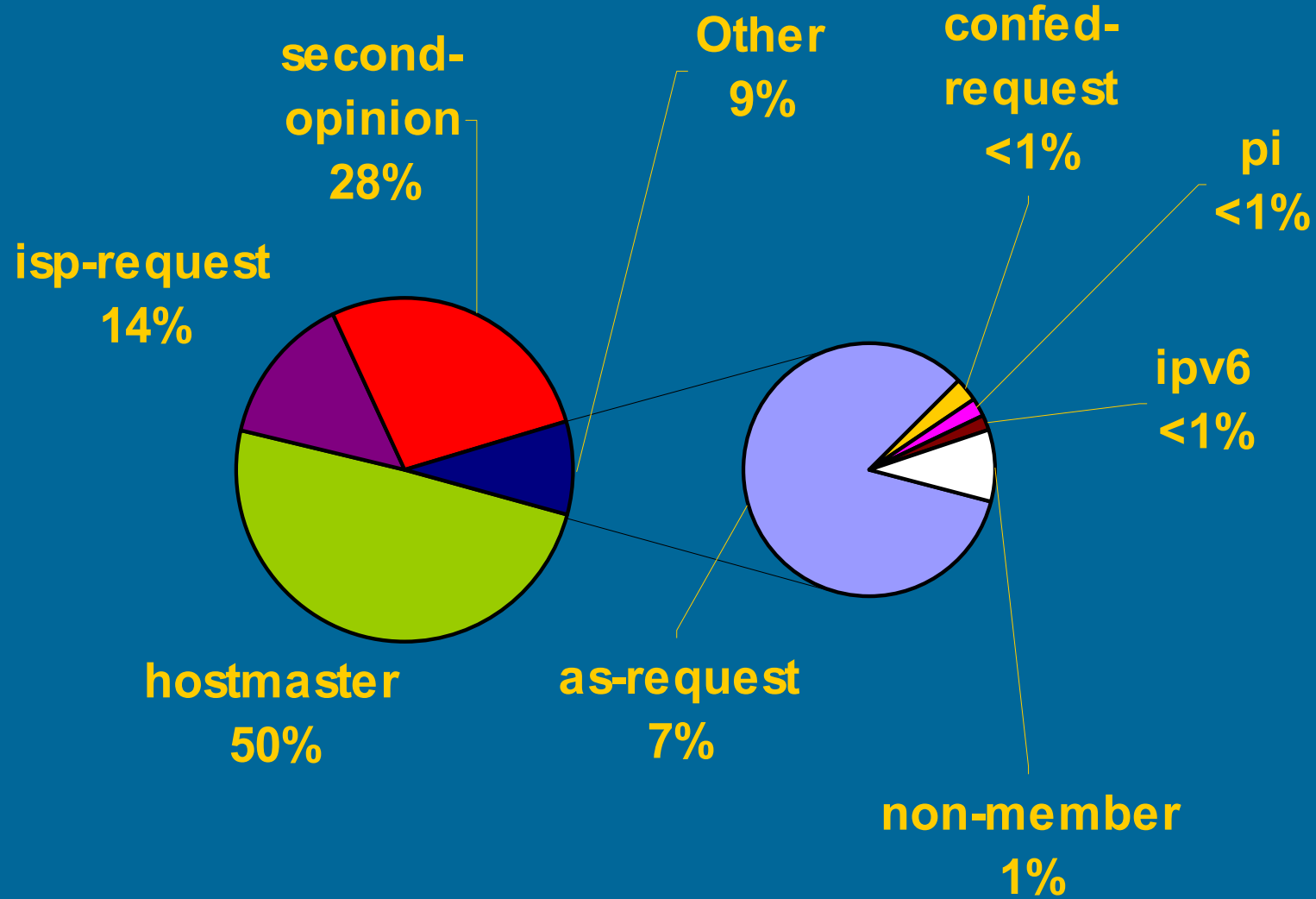
