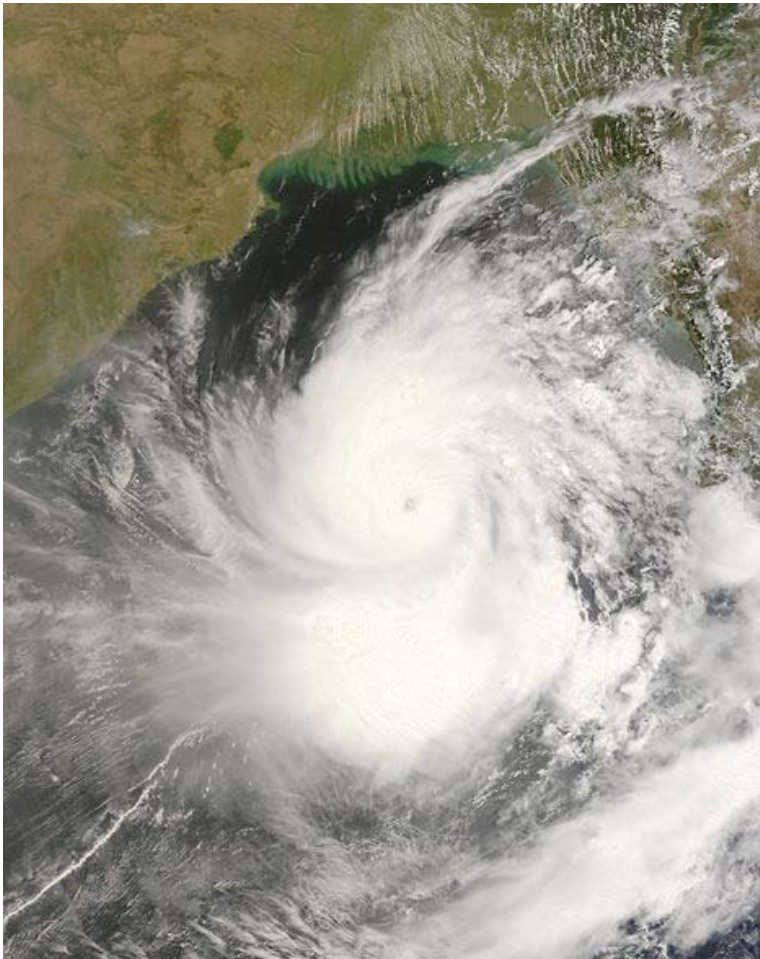
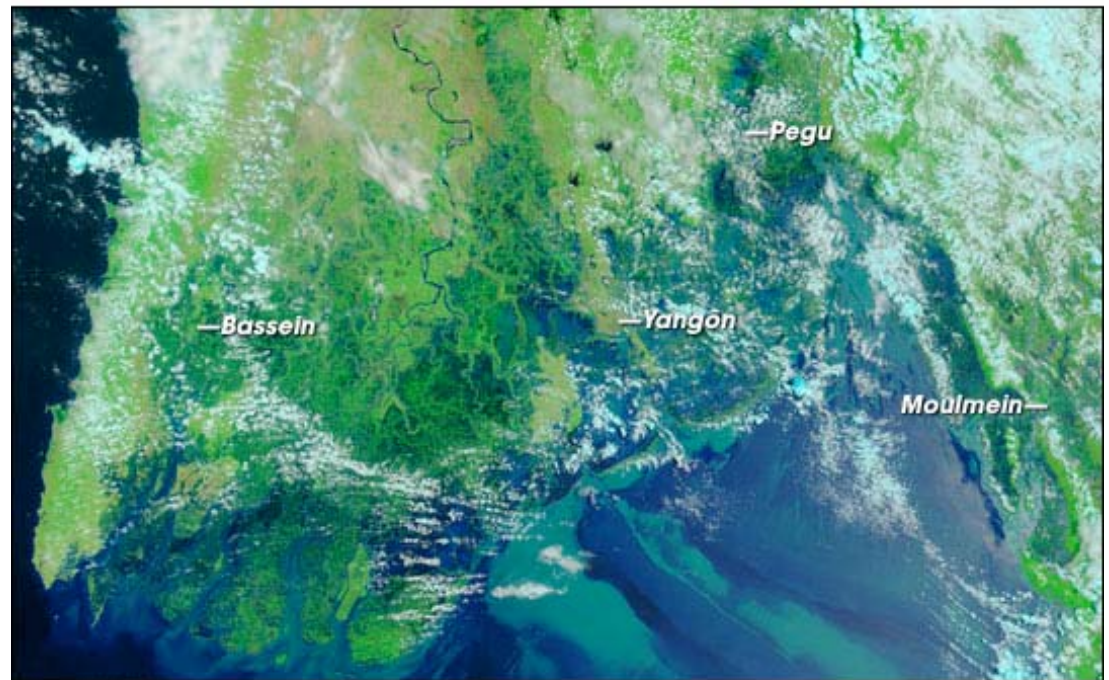



Operations of heterogeneous networks in emergency conditions will be explored.
