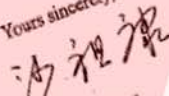
Dear Mr. Wilson,

I am writing to you to invite your organization to provide an annual performance report as a follow-up to the *Tunis Agenda on the Information Society*, which requested the Secretary-General to begin a process, involving all relevant organizations, towards enhanced cooperation on public policy issues pertaining to the Internet, in particular, paragraph 71 of the *Tunis Agenda* stating that "... relevant organizations shall be requested to provide annual performance reports on the steps they have taken towards 'enhanced cooperation'".

In 2006, the Secretary-General's Special Adviser for Internet Governance, Mr. Nitin Desai, consulted with representatives of all stakeholder groups - government, the private sector, and civil society, as well as technical and academic communities - in order to find a common ground with reference to this process. In September 2006, Mr. Desai submitted a report with the results of these consultations. In August 2007, I was entrusted by the Secretary-General to continue the consultation process, especially on the next steps to be taken.

I thank you in advance for providing your annual performance report at your earliest convenience, which, along with the reports of other relevant organizations, will be summarized in the Secretary-General's progress report on WSIS.
